New exhibit presents photographers' views of the world

CARLSBAD — Photography enthusiast Lev Tsimring says he sees things better through a viewfinder.

"I see things other people would miss," Tsimring said. "I show photographs to my friends and they say, 'I've been to this place and I didn't see this.'"

Tsimring spent the first 30 years of his life in Russia, where he was born. He moved to San Diego in 1992 to do research at the University of California San Diego.

Tsimring is a physicist by day, but in his spare time he studies what he calls "patterns of life" with his camera.

Tsimring says on his Web site that his artistic interests range from abstract photography to portraits and landscape, but in all genres he strives to capture the
